Lake Wildwood Fishing Tournaments 2017

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All Illinois D.N.R. state regulations apply.

All Lake Wildwood boat regulations apply.

Boats All boats must be equipped with some form of aerated live well.

Participants and Eligibility Tournaments are limited to 15 boats. At least one contestant per boat must be a member of Lake Wildwood.

Permitted Fishing Methods All bass must be caught alive in a conventional sporting manner. Only artificial lures may be used, with the exception of pork trailers. Trolling as a method of fishing is prohibited.

Size and Creel Limits Creel limit shall be a total of five (5) – 14" fish per team (largemouth and smallmouth). All fish need to be immediately released after the weigh-in.

Late Penalty Official time shall be determined at takeoff. Contestants will be penalized 1 pound per minute deducted from the total weight including any weight to be counted toward a big bass award. Any contestant more than 10 minutes late will be disqualified.

Dead Fish Penalty ½ pound will be deducted from the total weight for each dead bass presented for weigh-in.

Short Fish Penalty Short bass presented for weigh-in will be penalized at the rate of 1 pound for each non-legal bass presented.

Courtesy Bump The official bump board will be made available for contestants to use as a courtesy bump prior to the official weigh-in.

Ties Ties for 1st place only shall be broken by the biggest fish of each individual. Other ties will add places and divide points or cash awards evenly.

Entry Fee \$50 per boat. \$10 of this entry will be used to award big fish awards for both largemouth and smallmouth.
