DECAL PLACEMENT

STEP 1: THE MATERIALS

Each watercraft is required to have the following three items displayed on it at all times:

- i. Current Association issued decal.
- ii. Current State Department of Natural Resources tag.
- iii. Association lot numbers.

The Association decal may be purchased at the office or front gate guardhouse once the proper paperwork is on file for the watercraft.

The State Department of Natural Resources tag will be issued to you by the State.

The Association lot numbers will need to be at least 3" in height and will need to contrast with the boat color in order to ensure visibility.

STEP 2: THE PLACEMENT

i. The Association decal is to be displayed on the port (left) stern (rear) gunwale (upper edge of a boat's side).

ii. The State Department of Natural Resources tag (if applicable to the watercraft) is to be displayed on both sides of the bow (front of the boat). Generally, the DNR tag is placed at the end of the registration number (see notice below for more information).

iii. The Association lot numbers are to be displayed at the stern (rear) of the boat on both sides (left and right).
